SCHEDULING ORDER

This cause came before the Court for hearing on June 9, 2010. Counsel for all parties, including the intervenors (collectively, the "Parties"), were present personally or telephonically.

Consistent with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(g) and the agreement of counsel, and being otherwise fully advised, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Intervening Plaintiff, Florida Senate, shall serve its complaint on or before June 14, 2010. Defendant shall file responses to the pleadings of Plaintiffs and Intervening Plaintiffs on or before June 28, 2010.
2. Plaintiffs and Intervening Plaintiffs shall serve witness and exhibit lists and expert witness disclosures on or before July 6, 2010. Defendant shall serve witness and exhibit lists and expert witness disclosures on or before July 12, 2010. The expert witness disclosures shall

identify all expert witness intended to be called at trial and briefly summarize the expert witness' expected testimony.


3. The Parties shall serve any dispositive motions on or before July 16, 2010, and any responses to such dispositive motions on or before July 21, 2010.

4. The discovery period shall close on July 21, 2010.

5. All papers which, under the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure or this Scheduling Order, are required to be served on the Parties, shall additionally be furnished to the Parties by electronic mail no later than the date of service. All responses by the Parties to requests for written discovery shall be due within 20 days after the date of service by electronic mail, without regard to Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.090(e).

6. The Court shall conduct a non-jury trial at the Leon County Courthouse, 301 South Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida, beginning on July 26, 2010. Counsel shall be present and prepared to begin proceedings at 7:30 a.m. The Court may hear argument on any dispositive motions before trial at a time to be determined.
