




adequate remedy at law, and it is in the public interest to ensure that Hillsborough County voters are not asked to vote on an unlawful amendment to the Hillsborough County Charter, or on an amendment as to which the ballot title and summary language is misleading as to the true effect of the proposed amendment.

The grounds for this Motion are more fully set forth in the accompanying Memorandum of Law, which is incorporated herein by reference.

**WHEREFORE**, the Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court enter a temporary injunction prohibiting Defendant from placing Charter Amendment Petition 06-5 on the ballot for the November 2008 general election, and grant Plaintiff such other and further relief as this Court may deem just and proper.
