MOTION TO INTERVENE AS PARTY PLAINTIFFS

Potential Intervenors, GOVERNMENT SUPERVISORS ASSOCIATION OF FLORIDA, OFFICE AND PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION, LOCAL 100 ("GSAF") and GREGORY L. BLACKMAN ("BLACKMAN"), move to intervene in the above-styled matter as party plaintiffs pursuant to Rule 1.230, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure. As grounds for the intervention, the potential intervenors state:

1. Potential Intervenor, GSAF, is the state certified collective bargaining agent for the Professionals and Supervisors employed by Miami-Dade County and Broward County. As such the GSAF is legally responsible and obligated to negotiate with Broward and Dade Counties over wages, hours and terms/conditions of employment for more than 4,000 employees who are participants in the Florida Retirement System.

2. The members of the bargaining units represented by GSAF, have a real and direct interest in the pending litigation.

3. Potential Intervenor, BLACKMAN, is the President of the GSAF. He is a Rail Traffic Controller employed by Miami-Dade County Transit Agency. He is a participant in the Florida Retirement System.

4. The Plaintiffs in this case have consented to the motion. The Defendants have not, at this time, asserted a position on the intervention. Once counsel for the Defendants are identified by the undersigned, an effort to obtain their permission to intervene in the lawsuit will be sought.

5. For the information of the Court and the Defendants, Potential Intervenors GSAF and BLACKMAN adopt:

(a) the complaint for declaratory and injunctive relief as well as the legal positions asserted therein;

(b) the motion for temporary injunction as well as the legal positions asserted therein; and


(c) the memorandum of law in support of plaintiffs' motion for temporary injunction as well as the legal positions asserted therein.


